

Recreation & Wildlife Commission Orders
Apply from August 01, 2021 to July 31, 2022

I. San Carlos Apache Tribe, Recreation & Wildlife Code, Section 6 – Application of Law

Any person who shall enter within the exterior boundaries of the Reservation shall become subject to this Code and all rules, regulations and orders of the Commission, and shall be deemed to have impliedly consented to the jurisdiction of the Tribal Court, and shall be subject to prosecution in the Tribal court for violations of the provisions contained in this Code and all rules, regulations and orders of the Commission. Such persons also shall have been deemed to have impliedly consented to the jurisdiction of the Tribal Law Enforcement and Game Rangers.

II. Recreation & Wildlife Commission Orders

These Commission Orders have been enacted by the San Carlos Recreation and Wildlife Commission pursuant to and in accordance with Recreation & Wildlife Code, Section 8, A, (6) and (7) and relate to the opening, closing, or altering seasons and establishing bag and possession limits for wildlife on the San Carlos Apache Indian Reservation.

- 2) Hunters are required to submit a questionnaire on their bear hunt within 10 business days. Failure to do so will prohibit the hunter from purchasing another big game tag.
- 3) All harvested animals are required to be checked in with Game and Fish staff, wildlife management or law enforcement.
- 4) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.

- 5) There is a \$10.00, non-refundable administrative fee for entering the lottery for the September Dry Lake, Hilltop, Nine Mile, and Malay Gap elk hunts.
- 6) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 7) The last day to purchase tag will be on the last Saturday of March 12:00 p.m.
- 8) An alternate list will be made available by Recreation & Wildlife Department for hunters unable to hunt and/or were drawn successfully in other areas.
- 9) Only one chance (one lottery ticket) per person per lottery.

- 10) Only one Elk Tag per season.
- 11) Hunters are required to submit a questionnaire on their elk hunt within 10 business days. Failure to do so will prohibit the hunter from purchasing another big game tag.
- 12) All harvested animals are required to be checked in with Game and Fish staff, wildlife management or law enforcement.

- 4) Juniors 10 -13 years of age must have completed a Hunter Education Class before they hunt.
- 5) A valid hunting permit is required to enter each and every draw hunt.
- 6) Dates to enter drawing will be January 02, 2021 to February 27, 2021. Lottery will close at 12:00 p.m. on February 27, 2021. The public lottery drawing will be held on March 01, 2021 at 09:00 a.m. @ Recreation & Wildlife Department.
- 7) There is a \$10.00, non-refundable administrative fee for entering the lottery for the September Dry Lake, Hilltop, Nine Mile, and Malay Gap elk hunts.
- 8) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 9) The last day to purchase tag will be on the last Saturday of March 12:00 p.m.
- 10) An alternate list will be made available by Recreation & Wildlife Department for hunters unable to hunt and/or were drawn successfully in other areas.
- 11) Only one chance (one lottery ticket) per person per lottery.
- 12) All harvested animals are required to be checked in with Game and Fish staff, wildlife management or law enforcement.
- 13) One Elk Tag per season.

- 5) There is a \$10.00, non-refundable administrative fee for entering the lottery for the September Dry Lake, Hilltop, Nine Mile, and Malay Gap elk hunts.
- 6) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 7) The last day to purchase tag will be on the last Saturday of March 12:00 p.m.
- 8) An alternate list will be made available by the Recreation & Wildlife Department for hunters unable to hunt and/or were drawn successfully in other areas.
- 9) Only one chance (one lottery ticket) per person per lottery.

- 2) A valid hunting permit is required to enter each and every draw hunt.
- 3) Dates to enter drawing will be January 02, 2021 to February 27, 2021. Lottery will close at 12:00 p.m. on February 27, 2021. The public lottery drawing will be held on March 01, 2021 at 09:00 a.m. @ Recreation & Wildlife Department.
- 4) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 5) The last day to purchase tag will be on the last Saturday of March 12:00 p.m.
- 6) All harvested animals are required to be checked in with Game and Fish staff, wildlife management or law enforcement.
- 7) Hunters are required to submit a questionnaire on their deer hunt within 10 business days. Failure to do so will prohibit the hunter from purchasing another big game tag.

 - No harvest in fall, harvest one turkey in spring hunt #1 and harvest one turkey in spring hunt #2.
 - Harvest one turkey in fall, and harvest one turkey in spring hunt #2.
 - May harvest two (2) turkeys if the hunter possesses two double turkey tags.

- 2) Hunters are required to submit a questionnaire on their turkey hunt within 10 business days. Failure to do so will prohibit the hunter from purchasing another big game tag.

- 5) There is a \$10.00, non- refundable administrative fee for entering the lottery for the December Dry Lake, Nine Mile, Hilltop, and Malay Gap elk hunts.
- 6) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 7) The last day to purchase tag will be on the last Saturday of March 12:00 p.m.
- 8) An alternate list will be made available by Recreation & Wildlife Department for hunters unable to hunt and/or were drawn successfully in other areas. Any name drawn after the allotted number of hunters will automatically go to an alternate list.
- 9) Only one chance (one lottery ticket) per person lottery.

- 10) During the Malay Gap Elk hunts, no camping is allowed north of road 1900 from BS Gap Tank to east boundary reservation line. No camping is permitted on any roads north of the 1900 road except road number 2034 and along 2000 to the Heartbreak Hotel campsite. Campsites must be within ¼ mile from the road. (Commission Regulation 017)
- 11) All vehicles must stop at checkpoints or check stations manned by San Carlos Recreation & Wildlife Department Personnel. (Commission Regulation 016)
- 12) One Elk tag per season.
- 13) Hunters are required to submit a questionnaire on their elk hunt within 10 business days. Failure to do so will prohibit the hunter from purchasing another big game tag.
- 14) All harvested animals are required to be checked in with Game and Fish staff, wildlife management or law enforcement.

- 2) All vehicles must stop at checkpoints or check stations manned by San Carlos Recreation & Wildlife Department Personnel. (Commission Regulation 016)
- 3) Archery Hunters are prohibited from possessing a firearm while in possession of an Archery Deer Tag.
- 4) All Archery Deer hunters must report to the Game and Fish department to demonstrate the use of their archery equipment within 5 business days of selecting their hunt. Hunter must exhibit basic knowledge of equipment and ability to shoot.
- 5) A valid hunting permit is required to enter each and every draw hunt.
- 6) Dates to enter drawing will be January 02, 2021 to February 27, 2021. Lottery will close at 12:00 p.m. on February 27, 2021. The public lottery drawing will be held on March 01, 2021 at 09:00 a.m. @ Recreation & Wildlife Department.
- 7) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 8) The last day to purchase tag will be on the last Saturday of March 12:00 p.m.
- 9) All vehicles must stop at checkpoints or check stations manned by San Carlos Recreation & Wildlife Department Personnel. (Commission Regulation 016)

- 1) Lion hunters to report any lion killed to the San Carlos Recreation & Wildlife Department headquarters during regular business days within three business days of the kill.
- 2) A Mountain Lion Tag is only required if a hunter is transporting a Mountain Lion off the reservation for any purpose such as Taxidermy.
- 3) Radio Collared or ear tagged mountain lions may be harvested, the radio collar must be returned to the Wildlife Management Department.

Possession Limit: The possession of ducks including mergansers; Fourteen (14) after opening day, only seven (7) of which may be taken any one day, but no more than:

- a. Four (4) redheads
- b. Four (4) female mallards or Mexican-like ducks
- c. Four (4) pintails
- d. Six (6) scaup
- e. Two (2) canvasbacks.

Coots and common moorhens (gallinules): twenty-five (25) singly or in the aggregate. Geese: Twelve (12) white geese (snow, including blue and Ross' geese) and six (6) dark geese (Canada and White fronted).

Procedure Rule:

- 1) Federal Duck Stamp must be signed and affixed to a hunting license in possession while hunting waterfowl
- 2) Duplicate License, Tag and Habitat Stamp will cost the same as the original fee per item.
- 3) Steel, bismuth, tungsten/polymer, tungsten-nickel-iron, and tungsten matrix shots are approved as non-toxic shot.

ADDENDUM TO THE RECREATION & WILDLIFE COMMISSION REGULATIONS

Reg. 027 – Enrolled members of the San Carlos Apache Tribe, sixty (60) years of age or older are eligible to receive a complimentary hunting and/or fishing license. The complimentary hunting and/or fishing license will be issued without cost to the person receiving such a license. Applicants for this license shall provide proof of enrollment and age to the San Carlos Recreation & Wildlife Department prior to receiving a complimentary permit.

Procedure Rule:

- 1) Free license only, must still purchase Big Game Tags and Habitat Stamp at cost.
